## REGISTRATION:

- ① Manual: soft 8' String with Céleste  
Pedal: same as Manual (no 16')
- ② Manual: Foundations 8' & 4'  
Pedal: same as Manual with appropriate 16'
- ③ Manual: Foundations 8', 4', & 2', with light Mixture  
Pedal: same as Manual with appropriate 16'
- ④ Manual: soft 8' String with Céleste and light 4' Flute if needed  
Pedal: same as Manual with appropriate 16', and 4' Flute or Foundation for clarity
- ⑤ Full Foundations with Mixtures and Reeds
- ⑥ RH: powerful 8' Reed or potent combination  
LH: Foundations 8', 4', 2', with Mixture  
Pedal: same as LH with appropriate 16'
- ⑦ Full Organ with 16'
