- 1 SW: 8' String with Céleste  
GT: 8' Solo Flute  
PED: same as SW with appropriate 16'
- 2 SW: 8' String with Céleste, and fuller Foundations 8' & 4',  
GT: Foundational combination 8', 4', 22/3', 2' (Mixture)  
PED: same as, or similar to, SW with appropriate 16' (this combination should be clear and pronounced)
- 3 Full Organ (under expression) with Mixture(s) and Reeds
